

Care and Maintenance of Dropzone, Dropzone Speckle and Dropzone Interlocking Tiles

Tarkett Sports' Dropzone, Dropzone Speckle, and Dropzone Interlocking Tiles are extremely durable and easy to maintain. Follow these simple steps toward keeping your flooring clean and hygienic for your athletic participants.

Three Easy Steps:

Sweep, Wash, and Rinse. There is no need for the hassles and cost of applying waxes or other surface treatments.

General advice:

Resilient floors can be damaged by solvents. Wipe up any grease or stains immediately, as it may damage the surface. Avoid over application of cleaning solution and water on Dropzone Interlocking Tiles. Remove excess liquid immediately after application.



About 80% of surface soiling that has to be cleaned off is brought from outside. And 90% of that soiling can be avoided by an effective and correctly dimensioned entrance mat.



Dry Mopping / Sweeping Removes dust and dirt. Use yarn or micro-fiber mops, or soft bristled brooms. Avoid impregnated dust mops.



Wet Mopping / Scrubbing Removes embedded dirt and grime. Deck brushes are effective for stubborn areas. Use soft to medium bristled brushes for the best effect.

AND



Wet Vacuuming Removes dirty water. Be sure to rinse with clean water and vacuum afterward to remove all residues.



Wet Mopping Removes soil and other contaminants. Use a diluted neutral cleaner and rinse thoroughly to avoid heavy build up of residues.

OR



Auto-Scrubbing is more effective and efficient for large areas. Use a diluted neutral cleaner and rinse thoroughly to avoid heavy build up of residues. White pads are used for regular maintenance. Red pads are used for periodic deeper cleaning. Cylindrical units work well with these types of floors.



Treat stains immediately. Handle spot using a white rag with mineral spirits or neutral detergent (solvents should not be used) Work from the outside of the mark towards its center. Rinse with water and dry.
